# HOW TO RESPOND

## RUN

- Getting away from the shooter(s) is priority.
- Leave your belongings behind
- Help others escape, if possible, but evacuate regardless of whether others agree to follow.

## HIDE

- Get out of the shooter's view and stay very quiet.
- Silence all electronic devices and make sure they won't vibrate.
- Lock and block doors, close blinds and turn off lights.
- Don't hide in groups - spread out along walls or hide separately
- Try to communicate with police silently - ie. social media, text message or place a sign in window.
- Stay in place until law enforcement gives you all the clear.

## FIGHT

- Commit to your actions and act aggressively against the shooter
- Recruit others to ambush the shooter with makeshift weapons like chairs, fire extinguishers, etc.
- Be prepared to cause severe or lethal injury to the shooter
